

# YVR PAH Mosh Event Liability Waiver & Release

Effective 2025

This document outlines the terms and conditions that all participants agree to upon attending any YVR PAH Mosh event. Please read carefully before attending.

## 1. Assumption of Risk

Participants understand that YVR PAH events, including Mosh events, involve pet play activities, physical activity, close contact, shared play spaces, and dynamic environments. Participation involves inherent risks, including but not limited to physical injury or collision, emotional or psychological discomfort, property damage or loss, exposure to communicable illness, and other unforeseen risks inherent to group activities.

By attending, participants voluntarily assume all risks, known and unknown, associated with their participation.

## 2. Voluntary Participation

Participation in YVR PAH events is entirely voluntary. Participants confirm that they are physically and mentally capable of participating and may disengage or leave at any time without penalty or obligation.

## 3. Health & Wellness Declaration

Participants confirm that they are not currently experiencing symptoms of any communicable illness (including but not limited to fever, cough, or gastrointestinal symptoms) and agree not to attend any YVR PAH event if symptomatic. Participants understand that close-contact activities carry inherent health risks and accept responsibility for their own health decisions.

## 4. Code of Conduct Acknowledgement

Participants acknowledge that they have read, understand, and agree to abide by the **YVR PAH Code of Conduct – 2025**, including all consent expectations and boundaries, photography and

privacy rules, designated gear levels for the event, Mosh-specific rules (play mat etiquette, footwear, contact limitations), and general expectations for respect, inclusivity, and safety.

Failure to comply with the Code of Conduct may result in immediate removal from the event and/or exclusion from future YVR PAH events or spaces, without refund.

## **5. Venue Rules & Policies**

Participants agree to comply with all venue-specific rules and policies. No outside food or beverages are permitted at the venue. Participants must adhere to all venue capacity, noise, and conduct requirements, as well as any additional venue-specific policies communicated by event organizers.

## **6. Release of Liability**

To the fullest extent permitted by law, participants release and hold harmless YVR PAH, its organizers, volunteers, venue partners, and affiliated parties from any and all claims, losses, damages, or liabilities arising from participation in YVR PAH events, except in cases of gross negligence or willful misconduct.

## **7. Indemnification**

Participants agree to indemnify and hold harmless YVR PAH, its organizers, volunteers, venue partners, and affiliated parties from any claims, damages, losses, or legal expenses arising from their actions or omissions at YVR PAH events, failure to comply with the Code of Conduct or event rules, or any damage caused to the venue, equipment, or other participants.

## **8. Personal Property**

YVR PAH and the venue are not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged personal property. Participants agree to safeguard their belongings and participate at their own risk.

## **9. Photography & Media**

Photography and media rules are governed by the YVR PAH Code of Conduct. Participants agree to follow all consent and privacy requirements. Consent for photography or video for community or promotional purposes will be obtained at the event.

## **10. Age & Legal Acknowledgement**

All participants must be 19 years of age or older, the age of majority in British Columbia, and legally able to enter into this agreement.

## **11. Severability**

If any provision of this waiver is found to be invalid or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions shall continue in full force and effect.

## **12. Governing Law**

This agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the Province of British Columbia and the applicable laws of Canada.

## **13. Agreement by Participation**

By attending any YVR PAH Mosh event, participants acknowledge that they have read and fully understood this waiver and agree to its terms. Participation constitutes acceptance of all conditions outlined herein and acknowledgement that certain legal rights, including the right to sue, are being voluntarily waived.
